Roles and Responsibilities:

- Partner with operations and engineering teams to provide air permitting and compliance support.
- Perform calculations for emissions inventories, permitting and compliance demonstrations and prepare air permit applications.
- Assist in the development, implementation, and maintenance of environmental programs, systems, and procedures to ensure compliance with air permit requirements and environmental regulations.
- Prepare and submit environmental reports to state and federal agencies and management teams.
- Assist with the preparation and upkeep of environmental data in compliance tracking systems.
- Review, interpret, and maintain an understanding of new and existing State and Federal air quality regulations.
- Assist with internal and external compliance audits and collaborate with cross-functional teams to implement compliance actions.
- Conduct field inspections, audits, and data collection as necessary. All field travel is within 2 hours of Denver.
